## Endoscopic Video Case Submission

**SUBMISSION DEADLINE** Monday, 31 May 2018

### GUIDELINES

1. Subject matter must be endoscopic in nature and pose a clinical challenge or demonstrate an intriguing technique
2. Files may be no more than 3 minutes in length and may include a narrative audio track that will be used for review purposes, but will not be part of the live presentation
3. Four videos will be selected. If chosen, you must be present to narrate your video during the video forum. A two-minute panel discussion will follow each presentation
4. An award will be presented to the top video
