- 2. Files may be no more than 3 minutes in length and may include a narrative audio track that will be used for review purposes, but will not be part of the live presentation
- 3. Four videos will be selected. If chosen, you must be present to narrate your video during the video forum. A two-minute panel discussion will follow each presentation
- 4. An award will be presented to the top video
